On the 1st of August 2011 the city council met in a public hearing to take testimony regarding the regarding a request by Douglas Moscrip of 7923 Richey Rd, Fruitland, Idaho to vacate Moscrip Estates Subdivision including Leigh Street in the same subdivision. The subject property is located approximately 100 feet south of the intersection of South Plymouth Avenue and SW 2nd Ave in Section 9 T 7 N, R 4 W, Boise Meridian.

The meeting was called to order at approximately 6:50 pm by Mayor Joe Cook. Roll call was taken with Councilmember's Mayer, Cline and York in attendance. Councilman Esplin was out of town. Staff members present included Leon K. Jensen. Others in attendance were Doug Moscrip and his wife and Rick and Barbara Postlethwait.

The meeting was opened for public testimony. Mr. Moscrip testified that he needed to vacate the plat, lots 4-11, and settle his estate since the death of his first wife. He explained some of the legal requirements for the settlement. There was no testimony from the public.

Councilwoman Mayer moved to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Cline. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.
