

CITY COUNCIL BUDGET WORKSHOP

On the 21st of July 2016, the New Plymouth City Council Budget Workshop was called to order at 5:58 PM by Mayor Beth Earles. Roll call was taken with council members Ron Rouse, Bill Warnke, Rick York and Cora Kurth in attendance.

Staff members in attendance were City Clerk Danielle Painter, Public Works Superintendent Beau Ziemer and Deputy Clerk Alishia Elliott.

Councilman Warnke moved to approve the agenda. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.

FY2017 Budget

The city council went through each page of the budget and discussed the different questions they had with City Clerk and Public Works Superintendent. The City Council started with the general fund revenue information and ended with Sanitation expenses. Mayor Earles also stated that she would eventually want to have the city make donations to the Snake River Transit and Snake River EDA. There was also talk about a possible increase in the Payette County Sheriff's contract in fiscal year 2018. The City Council agreed to have the revenue sharing that was being given to the Library fund given to the general fund for updates in City Hall.

Councilman Warnke moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.
