On the 6th of January, 2016, the New Plymouth City Council special meeting was called to order at 6 pm by Mayor Beth Earles. Roll call was taken with council members Warnke, Rouse, Kurth, and York in attendance.

Staff members in attendance were City Clerk Danielle Painter and Deputy Clerk Alishia Elliott

Residents in attendance were Roxanna Cline.

Regular Agenda – **Councilman Warnke moved to approve regular agenda. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.**

New Business

Reschedule Regular City Council Meeting set for January 18th, 2016 – **Councilman York made a motion to move the City Council meeting to January 19th, 2016 at 6:30 P.M. Councilman Warnke seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.**

Appoint 2nd signer for review of claims – **Councilman York moved to appoint Councilwoman Kurth as the 2nd signer for review of claims. Councilman Warnke seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.**

Appoint Animal Control Board / Discussion – Mayor Earles appointed Councilman Warnke, Toby Haantz (Payette County Sheriff's Representative), Sean King, Mike Burgin, Joe Cook, and Roxanna Cline to the Animal Control Board. Councilman Rouse stated that the ordinance states the dog needs to be placed into custody until the Animal Control Board finalizes their decision. Mayor Earles stated she will contact Payette County Sheriff Chad Huff, and will ask for the dog to be taken and impounded at All Creatures Animal Hospital in New Plymouth until the Animal Control Board reaches a decision. **Councilman Warnke motioned to approve the appointment of the Animal Control Board, Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.**

Councilman York motioned to adjourn the council meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Warnke. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.
