

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

The City of New Plymouth, Idaho is requesting bids for the construction of the **Horseshoe Park Pathway**. The project, located within Southeast Blvd. from South Plymouth Avenue to Southeast Avenue, includes approx. 1030 square yards of asphalt pathway construction, two (2) new ADA ramps, two (2) pedestrian-activated flashing LED crosswalk warning signs, and other related items as specified in the plans and contract documents.

Sealed bids for the described project will be received at the New Plymouth City Hall, 301 N. Plymouth Ave., P.O. Box 158, New Plymouth, ID 83655, until **9:00 A.M.** (local time) on **October 3, 2018**. Sealed bids will be publicly opened and read at that time. Bids submitted after the above specified time shall not be received or opened.

Each SIGNED bid shall be submitted on the OFFICIAL BIDDING DOCUMENTS and in the manner as indicated in the Instructions to Bidders and said bid shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. The bid bond shall be issued by a surety authorized and licensed to issue such bonds in the State of Idaho. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "*Bid for the City of New Plymouth, Idaho – Horseshoe Park Pathway, New Plymouth, KN18680*" and show the name and business address of the bidder. Any bid that does not include the enclosed official bidding document packet as prescribed, completed and signed, will be considered an incomplete bid and returned to bidder.

The City of NEW PLYMOUTH reserves the right to accept the proposals and award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder; to postpone the acceptance of the proposal and the award of the contract for a period not to exceed **40** calendar days; or to reject any and all proposals received and further advertise the project for bids. The City may reject any bid not in compliance with all the prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements and may reject for good cause any or all bids upon a finding that it is in the public interest to do so.

When awarded a contract, the successful bidder shall promptly execute the contract and shall furnish a performance and payment bond each in the full amount of the contract price. The entire project awarded shall be substantially complete on or before **35** calendar days after the Contract Time start date listed on the Notice to Proceed and complete and ready for final payment on or before 45 calendar days after the Contract Time start date.

This Federal-Aid Project is subject to certain non-discrimination, Buy American, and Davis Bacon Wage Act requirements. Bidders and Contractors must comply with the requirements set forth in the project specifications.
