### Citizen Comments-

SREDA used to come to the council and ask for a donation, they are an asset for assisting with the city's revitalization. They can help with grants for things like a splash pad, parks and the water wheel. The council could possibly assign a liaison to work with Payette County Sheriff, to report traffic issues and ordinance violations.

### Mayor & Council Comments

The discussion of requiring more time spent by deputies in the city if they are going to ask for more money for their contract. If we are paying more, we want more presence here. Superintendent Beau Ziemer said that not too long ago the high school was trying to get a resource officer, maybe the city can pair up with the school for the cost of a full-time officer. Councilmember Ron Martinez said there as been some talk of what might be being planned for the Internet Truck Stop building. Scott Moscrip has been hired as the new CEO. He will no doubt have some great business ideas for that space.
